Senior: 19+ Years	Full member of the club	\$275

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP GROUPS

“Hotshots” : red & orange soft tennis ball (generally age 9 years and under)

Coaching, games and social tennis throughout the summer Term 4 and Term 1

Under the direction of the head coach Nic Jenkins and Rhys Weaver. Children are divided into small groups of about 6, each led by the qualified coaches alongside skilled assistants. Play is fun and encouragement based, using mini-courts and soft balls.

“Hotshots”: **green ball** (Age over 9)

Coaching, games and development towards competitive play, throughout the summer Term 4 and Term 1

Under the direction of the head coach Nic Jenkins and Rhys Weaver. Children are divided into small groups of about 4 to 6, each led by the qualified coaches. Play is fun and encouragement based and some juniors will progress into competition teams.

Junior. Participation in Interclub competition teams; 9 to 18 years old.

Avonhead has many teams playing inter-club competitions, Friday late afternoon or Saturday morning. The head coach offers each team (of about 4 or 5) preparation for inter-club competition, support and of specialist coaching, at an allocated time during the week. The coach manages the teams, with the assistance of the Club Junior Convenor.

NOTES

Year: The Club tennis year is from 1 September to 31 August. Some ‘Age Competitions’ use the age that the Junior is on the 1st of January in the middle of the tennis year.

Interclub competition: You must be a paid-up financial member before starting interclub matches.

Coaching: AVONHEAD is a development club, so junior interclub competition players are expected to participate in the coaching programme, unless they are accepted into a team after joining as a Senior ‘Young Adult’ member.

Senior ‘Casual off-peak’ Subscription: Parents/Caregivers or brothers/sisters of a Junior who wish to assist the Junior with ‘hit-ups’ or social tennis are expected to support the club and join, with at least, a ‘Casual off-peak’ membership. The club encourages the participation of parents but needs your assistance to help fund the tennis courts which you play on.

Court Use: Junior Members can use the courts at other approved times, outside of their coaching schedule.

NOTE: members cannot use the courts to play with non-members, unless the non-member pays the guest fee of \$10 and it’s for no longer than 1 or 2 sessions a season. After 5pm, juniors must give up the courts if senior members wish to play.

Juniors may have a complimentary ‘hit-up’ with others in the family on Sundays (preferably mornings) but must give up the courts if club members wish to play.

OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS WHO WISH TO USE THE COURTS ARE EXPECTED TO JOIN THE CLUB.
